You just have to go off what's happening.

DOES YOUR FAMILY REQUEST CAKES OFTEN?

BROTHERS PLAY sports and don't really eat that stuff, and neither do my parents. I do [like cake], but I don't eat it a lot. If it's just the tops of the cake, me and my brother will eat them or take them to his friends, but other than that, I don't make cakes for me. I make them for other people... and money.

DO YOU REMEMBER EACH OF THE CAKES YOU'VE MADE?

[I'VE MADE] MAYBE 200 over two or three years. [I remember] most of them for the final product. I like finishing it, when it's just me. Everyone always has the same reaction; it's like, "Oh my God!" and then every time, I'm like "Thanks..." and it's kinda awkward.
